



GIRL SCOUT COOKIE BOOTH GUIDELINES

DO	DO NOT
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Decorate your booth and check out costumes and sign from the Resource Center. ➤ Wear a uniform, G.S. t-shirt or G.S. pin. ➤ Be polite and friendly. ➤ Stay out of the doorways and walkways. Remain behind your table. ➤ Protect your money. ➤ Say THANK YOU whether they buy or not. ➤ Advertise your charity for "Gift of Caring" and ask customers to donate a box. ➤ Remove empty boxes and trash from area when you leave. ➤ Ask customers as they are "leaving" the business, more will buy as they are leaving. Do not harass customers entering the business. ➤ Train parents who will be helping at the booth sales. ➤ Turn in money as soon as possible after the sale. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Have more than 4 girls & 2 adults at the booth site. ➤ Yell or talk loudly. ➤ Run after or harass customers – let them come to you. ➤ Block the business doors. ➤ Approach cars. ➤ Run around or get in people's way. ➤ Ask customers twice. ➤ Go into the store while on duty. ➤ Ask the store for change or other supplies. ➤ Eat, drink or chew gum. ➤ Bring any tag-longs. Siblings or friends are not allowed at booth sales. ➤ Leave trash or boxes anywhere at the location. ➤ <u>Break down the boxes and take them with you when you leave.</u>

Selling Girl Scout Cookies at a Booth Sale is a privilege granted to us by the local merchants. These booth sales are a privilege, and if abused, even unintentionally, could cause all Girl Scouts to lose the opportunity for additional sales at these places of business, permanently.
