Activity Fees/Information for ALL Camp Properties:

Facilitated activities include pool & CWP lake slide, swimming, boating, archery, horseback riding and high/low challenge courses.

How to reserve a spot for a facilitated activity:

- Troop/Groups/Service Units must indicate on their camp registration form which activities they would like to do. If you have your own currently certified lifeguard, small craft safety, archery instructor, low ropes challenge course or high ropes/rock wall facilitators, please indicate it on your camp reservation form.
- Council staff schedules all activities and coordinates all facilitators.
- Troops pay a \$25 activity fee. Troops will be invoiced by council for necessary facilitator's fees at \$15 per hour per facilitator prior to camp date.
- Service Units pay a \$100 activity fee. SU's will be invoiced by council for necessary facilitators at \$15 per hour per facilitator prior to camp date.
- Troops and Service Units will receive an invoice/camp fee bill 60 days prior to camping date that includes fees for council-provided facilitators. Troop & Service Unit camp fees must be paid in full 30 days before camp date.

Service Units are to provide meals for the Wrangler(s) including the Riding Instructor. Troops will no longer provide meals for this group.
