Both Girl Scouts of the USA and our council review and evaluate forming local and national alliances with restaurants. Because they are donating back a percentage of sales to the council who is a 501 (c) (3) organization, that portion is considered a donation. From a legal perspective, service units and troops are a subdivision of the council, and the council is the only distinct legal entity and the only entity with tax exemption. Service units and troops are not 501 (c) (3) organizations, so a troop or service unit cannot enter into the same kind of alliance.
