3. I will communicate concerns through proper channels, not in the presence of the girls, and should I have a complaint or problem, I will share a suggested solution.
4. I will uphold the Girl Scout Promise and Law by demonstrating positive support and encouragement to my daughter and her troop members.
5. I will demand a Girl Scout environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco and alcohol and I will refrain from their use at all Girl Scout events.
6. I will place the emotional well being of my child ahead of my own personal aspirations in order to allow my daughter to be successful as a Girl Scout.
7. I will support the Girl Scout efforts to provide an environment of acceptance for all girls and their families. I will ask my child to treat others with respect regardless of race, color, ethnicity, creed, age, sex, disability, socio-economic status, or national origin.
