Colors in nature: the table will have paint, paintbrushes, water bowls and paper. Please help keep the table clean. It is better to give a little bit of paint than to give a lot and it gets wasted. Paintings can be hung to dry. If someone leaves a painting they will need to pick up their art by 2:00 pm. We do not have space to keep everybody's papers – ask adults to set a timer on their smart device reminding them to pick up their papers.

Brownie Elf Habitat

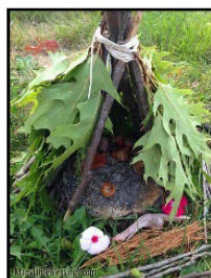
Table will have small figurines. Please look for nature items that are on the ground or have fallen off a tree/brush. Leaves and small twigs.
